Minutes of the 22nd meeting of Apex Committee of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) held 16.05.2019 under the Chairmanship of Secretary (HUA)

The Joint Secretary and National Mission Director welcomed Secretary (Housing and Urban Affairs) and officers from State/ UT Governments.

He outlined the agenda for the meeting and presented progress in project implementation. Discussions on the agenda items were initiated as follows:

Agenda 1. Progress in implementation of AMRUT

Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) was launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 25 June, 2015. The overall progress of the AMRUT Mission was briefly presented by the National Mission Director before the members of the Apex committee to apprise them about the current status.

Out of the total SAAP size of Rs.77,640 crore, works have been completed for 1,544 projects worth Rs.3,757 crore, contracts have been awarded and work in progress for 3,336 projects worth Rs.59,119 crore, 350 projects worth Rs.10,041 crore are under tendering and DPRs worth Rs.8,610 crore are to be tendered. Ministry has already released Rs.18,840 crore including Rs.13,574 crore as Central Assistance (CA) for projects. A total UC of Rs.12,375 crore has already been received by the Ministry. The progress of the Mission is as under:
